SCOTTISH RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP

2008 Challenges

2 WHEEL DRIVE CHALLENGE

Open to all Drivers registered in the Championship driving a 2-Wheel Drive car.
The following events will count towards the 2-Wheel Drive Challenge.

Brick & Steel Border Counties Rally	5 April
Station Garage Mitsubishi Granite City Rally	26 April
RSAC Scottish Rally	28 June
Colin McRae Forest Stages Rally	27 September

A Drivers best 3 scores will count towards their final Challenge point's total. The scoring system will reflect achievement against other registered competitors in the same **championship classes** and the level of registered competition in the classes.

Points will be allocated as follows: - **20, 18, 17, 16, 15 and so on down to 1 point**

An additional point will be awarded for each Challenge contender beaten in the capacity classes (including non-finishers), up to a maximum of 5 points.

In the event of a tie this will be resolved as defined in Section 5 of these Regulations.

End of season perpetual awards will be presented to the top 3 drivers in the final standings plus vouchers for the following:

1 st	-	6 Tyres
2 nd	-	4 Tyres
3 rd	-	2 Tyres

HISTORIC CHALLENGE

Open to all Drivers registered in the Championship driving Historic Category 1, 2 & 3 Rally Cars as defined in the General Regulations of the MSA.

A Drivers best 5 scores from the 8 Championship events will count towards their final Challenge point's total.

Points will be allocated as follows:- **15, 10, 8, 7, 6, ... , 1**
