14.6 SRC JOHN HORTON STAR DRIVE AWARD

~~Following the final event of the season, the names of the selected Star Driver winners from each event will be placed in a draw to decide the overall winner~~

The overall winner will be decided based on their performance which saw them nominated for the award along with input from merallydrive taken into account.

On Event Award

Star Drive Winner on each SRC event - merallydrive Virtual Mentor Session reviewing event In-Car with BRC Champion Matt Edwards

End of Season Award

~~The Overall Winning Driver and their Co-driver will receive a day's Personal Tuition, Practice, Setup and Pace note preparation with a renowned Rally Driver and Co-driver. There will be no cash alternative either in part or whole. SRC will not be responsible for the provision of a competition car or a co-driver.~~

The Overall Winning Driver and their Co-driver will receive a day's Test and Tuition day in a Dom Buckley RSC Ford Fiesta R5.

SRC will provide the Venue & Instructor, and cover the Insurance Premium for the test. The winner(s) may be responsible for providing a bond/guarantee to cover the excess on the Insurance policy. There may be an option to tailor the venue for this test to reduce risk, or alternatively for the winner to use their own vehicle as an alternative if so desired.

14.8 SRC CLUBMAN INCENTIVE SCHEME

Open to SRC registered competitors competing in the Clubman Category (Classes C1-C5), and also to Competitors in Classes H1 & H2 where their cars meet the technical regulations for the Clubman Category.

On Event Awards

The 3 winners from each SRC round will each receive a £200 Entry Discount voucher for subsequent rounds of the 2020/2021 SRC

- Performance of the Day Award
- The Clubman Spirit Award
- The Hard Charging Hard Luck Award

Winners for each category will be chosen by a panel consisting of SRC Management Team & SRC Media Team members, and input through the SRC Social Media channels is encouraged and will be taken into account when selecting the award winners on each event

14.9 RAVENOL CHALLENGE

An overall prize fund of £3000 is open to all registered drivers.

To be eligible, drivers must:

- Tick the relevant box on the Championship Signing-on sheet on every event entered
- Carry RAVENOL decals in a prominent position on each side of the car.
For clarity, these are separate to the RAVENOL decals which are included in the Championship Door Panel

RAVENOL Product voucher to the value of £200 to be presented on each event to the SRC registered driver showing the biggest improvement over their starting position in the final results.

In addition, there will be end of season Product awards to the value of £1600, details of which will be issued in a subsequent bulletin.

14.10 AMS ARNSIDE MOTORSPORT MITSUBISHI EVO PERFORMANCE AWARD

Open to SRC registered competitors competing in the Classes H2, C5, M8 & M9 in Mitsubishi Lancers or Galants.

At the end of the season, a panel consisting of 2 representatives from the SRC Management Team and a representative from AMS Arnside Motorsport will analyse all eligible competitors results & performances on each event throughout the season.

The Competitor achieving what is considered most impressive performance will receive a £500 voucher to be spent with AMS Arnside Motorsport
